## BROCAW BLAZERS HISTORY

Coach Ramsey founded the team in October of 1988 as tribute to a family of runners that he coached who were killed in a tragic car accident. Anyone from Kansas, Western Missouri and any adjacent AAU or USATF District, age 6-18, who wants to participate, is encouraged to do so. The team has competed in the CC Coaches National Youth Championships, AAU and USAT\&F Jr. Olympics Cross Country meets. The team has grown from 17 runners in 1988 to the point where we have had as many as 201 runners at the National Cross Country Meet on teams in six different age divisions. Coach Ramsey coordinates all training, travel, lodging, finances, logistics and activities for the team.

104 teams have also finished as National Cross Country Team Runner-up.
In 2021, we had what has been called the greatest overall team performance ever as eleven(11) of the twelve(12) teams in the different age divisions won the national title. Three other teams finished as national runner-up and one other team finished $3^{\text {rd }}$. We also added to our record as the only team in history to have a team (15-16 Boys and 17-18 Boys) finish $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the same race. This feat was accomplished in 2007, 2012 \& 2019 by our 13-14 Boys, in 2001, 2002, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 \& 2022 by our $15-16$ Girls, in 2014, 2021 \& 2023 by our 15-16 Boys, in 2003, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011 \& 2012 by our 17-18 Girls and in 1999, 2008, 2010, 2014, 2017, $2021 \& 2022$ by our 17-18 Boys. Since 1996 of the 308 races that have been contested, we have had a team in all except two. Of those 306 races, our team has finished as the National Champions 180 times, National Runner-up 89 times, and the $3^{\text {rd }}$ place finisher 48 times.

Winning Streaks - The 6-8 Boys have won the last 5 national titles in a row. The 13-14 Boys have won 18 of the last 20 national titles. The 15-16 Girls have won 7 of the last 8 national titles. The 15-16 Boys have won 17 of the last 19 national titles. The 17-18 Girls have won 18 of the last 21 national titles. The 17-18 Boys have won 17 of the last 20 national titles.
